**I. Introduction of HKU**

Established in 1911, The University of Hong Kong (HKU) is recognized as a world-class comprehensive research university. It offers internationally recognized qualifications and it is renowned for its academic and research excellence worldwide. As an English-medium university in China, HKU also offers researchers unique opportunities to bridge cultures and continents. There are 10 Faculties and around 45 academic departments and schools that engage in multi-disciplinary teaching and research. Today, the University has more than 28,000 students and 3,000 academic and research staff. HKU received a QS (Quacquarelli Symonds) World University Ranking of the 26th best university in the world in 2017-18.

► **Hong Kong PhD Fellowship (HKPF) Scheme<sup>^</sup>**

Fellowships of US\$30,760 (IDR\$410,369,160) per year plus conference and research-related travel allowance of US\$1,280 (IDR\$17,076,480) per year for selected full-time PhD candidates with outstanding academic performance and research ability/potential

► **University Postgraduate Fellowships (UPF)**

Fellowships of at least US\$27,360 (IDR\$365,009,760)<sup>\*#</sup> per year for selected full-time PhD candidates with excellent academic record

► **Postgraduate Scholarships (PGS)**

Scholarships currently at least US\$25,120 (IDR\$335,125,920)<sup>#</sup> per year for qualified full-time MPhil and PhD candidates
