NW NECKAR NOW summer school

CONTEXT

The School of Engineering and Architecture presents the first interdisciplinary Summer School "Neckar Now: Transformative approaches for a sustainable future" taking place from 16th until 23rd of August 2020.

The Neckar Now Summer School addresses the potential and challenges of a city along the river from an engineering and architectural perspective. Heidelberg provides the perfect setting to learn about current trends and methods of sustainable innovation and design. Field trips, input sessions and expert feedback rounds give the participants the ability to develop different approaches to local problems as well as to create their own projects in an immersive experience.

An exciting one-week program for those considering future studies in Water Technology (M.Eng.) or Architecture (B.A. or M.A.).

GOALS

1. To provide a common interdisciplinary scientific basis. The participants learn different methods of innovation management and are able to apply them in the field of water technology & architecture.
2. The participants learn through best practice examples and field trips different approaches based on the interaction between architecture and water technology and can apply them to their new project ideas.
3. To bring together a group of international students and discuss the tendencies and possibilities of different countries, sectors and social actors. At the same time the participants reflect on their intercultural similarities and differences.
4. At the end of the Summer School the participants are informed about the requirements for further studies and academic qualification paths in Germany.

1 Who is the program for ?

This program is designed for students of engineering, architecture, urban planning, geography, design and related fields. We particularly encourage applications from individuals who are interested in pursuing a Master's degree in Water Technology (M.Eng.) or Architecture (M.A.) at SRH Heidelberg University. We welcome all applicants, current university students may apply, as well as university graduates.

2 What is the language of instruction?

Our summer school is offered in English.

3 How much does the Summer School cost?

The Neckar Now Summer School is supported by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD). This funding covers the academic program, all study materials and cultural program and supports successful applicants with travel costs, accommodation, excursions, and subsistence. The grant for travel, accommodation and subsistence (including meals) is made by lump sum payments. The participants will receive the lump sums in cash in Heidelberg during the summer school.
